RESOLUTION NO. 2284

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE SOUTHWEST LOUISIANA REGIONAL PLANNING COMMISSION (SWLA-RPC) FOR LOUISIANA PLANNING DISTRICT 5 APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN SWLA-RPC AND THE CITY OF VINTON, LOUISIANA FOR PREPARATION OF AN ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT ADMINISTRATION GRANT FOR PUBLIC WORKS AND ECONOMIC ADJUSTMENT ASSISTANCE.

WHEREAS, the City of Vinton, Louisiana has determined a need for additional capacity of public utilities for the purpose of accommodating new industry locating in the Port of Vinton: **AND**

WHEREAS, the City of Vinton has identified locations, infrastructure and costs affecting utilities expansion needed for the new industry; **AND**

WHEREAS, the sewer and water infrastructure project aligns with the EDA strategic priorities, including advancing innovation and entrepreneurship by supporting the development of carbon sequestration facility that uses cutting-edge CCS technology; **AND**

WHEREAS, enhancing regional competitiveness by supporting the growth and diversification of regional industries, especially the petrochemical sector, and supporting environmentally sustainable development by supporting the reduction of greenhouse gas emissions and the promotion of clean energy; **AND**

WHEREAS, the City of Vinton is desirous of effective project grant preparation and management: **AND**

WHEREAS, an intergovernmental agreement between the Southwest Louisiana Regional Planning Commission and the City of Vinton for professional grant services provides the city with sound fiscal management, timely reporting and project implementation; **AND**

WHEREAS, the City of Vinton may from time to time identify additional grant management requirements not currently listed in the intergovernmental scope of work: **AND**

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of the Southwest Louisiana Regional Planning Commission has agreed, set, and adopted an hourly payable rate for proper accounting of time and resources;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE SOUTHWEST REGIONAL PLANNING COMMISSION APPROVING AND ADOPTING AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT WITH THE CITY OF VINTON, LOUISIANA FOR PROFESSIONAL GRANT PREPARATION AND MANAGEMENT SERVICES IDENTIFIED IN THE AGREEMENT SCOPE OF WORK AS NOTED IN ATTACHMENT A AND MADE A PART OF THIS RESOLUTION.

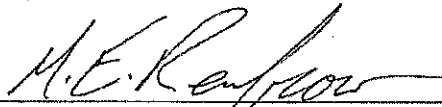
